

As you may know by now, BCC Cares dollars have been hard at work. We recently learned of a single mom with a 4-year old child who was out of work (and had been searching for quite a while). She was really struggling. Her unemployment was running out at the end of last week and food stamps at the end of the month. Scary times for this young mom. We reached out to her through her mom to see if our church family could help her. She gratefully accepted. BCC Cares paid for her January apartment rent and daycare expenses for one week. She received excellent news January 15th that she was hired for a position she had been seeking and could start two days later. A huge burden was lifted and prayers answered.

We can still help! She won't receive her first paycheck for three weeks so still needs help. With food stamps running out at the end of the month, the Missions Team is asking anyone who is interested to purchase Fareway gift cards for groceries and/or Casey's gift cards for gas. You may drop them off in the church office to Pam during office hours or put in an envelope marked "needy family" and place in the offering plate. Stewardship volunteers will set them aside so Pam will find on Monday morning. She will make sure they are received by the needy family. At this writing, one \$100 gift card to Fareway and 3 gift cards to Casey's totaling \$65 have been received. THANK YOU!!! If this is in your budget to help, it will be appreciated.

Thanks so much for your continued support of BCC Cares. The goodness it provides for struggling families is immeasurable.

Special Offering on February 18 & 25, 2024

The 2024 focus for Week of Compassion is “GIFTS TO LIVE ON”. Following is a small sampling of our dollars at work. Supporting this mission are dollars well spent.

GIFTS TO LIVE ON ... Girls' Education in Afghanistan

In present day, young women are now barred from education past the 6th grade. In a region historically familiar with the struggle for equity and liberation following decades of violence, generation after generation of Shia Muslims have been targeted, their basic human rights drastically restricted. Some schools that still meet are established and maintained by partners of Week of Compassion.

Week of Compassion's work rests in core values of accompaniment, community and integrity, not only when it flows easily, but in times of crisis. Along side global partners, Week of Compassion is expanding education for girls, bringing GIFTS TO LIVE ON in rural Afghanistan, communities that are marginalized and vastly underserved.

GIFTS TO LIVE ON ... Women's Clinics in South Sudan

South Sudan is a new country with major conflicts since it became its own nation in 2011. One of the side effects of the ongoing conflict is the impact on health systems, particularly for women and girls, who are especially vulnerable given the limited healthcare in the country. Providing such care is hard, and many women have to walk for miles to reach a health clinic. Week of Compassion supports a medical clinic in Juba because of the deep impact it has on the lives of patients who are ultimately victims of poor maternal health services.

GIFTS TO LIVE ON ... Strawberries & Bicycles: How One Community Welcomes Refugees

A car full of strawberries and a classroom full of clothes; applause for asking questions and quick thumbed typing into Google Translate; well-coordinated schedules and unexpected on-call moments ... Local congregations involved in refugee response moments know all of these challenges, rejoice in every success, and have countless stories to tell. This is the story of how two churches (First Baptist Church of Ashland, VA and Ashland Christian Church – Disciples of Christ) worked along side Reestablish Richmond, a local assistance agency, as volunteers went through needed training to help arriving Afghan refugees. They wanted them to feel welcome and have the help they needed. Volunteers are quick to point out that language skills aren't a requirement. With good humor, lots of gestures, and a phone open to Google Translate, they've found that lacking a common language doesn't have to be an actual barrier.

With an ongoing influx of refugees from recent crises, as well as families who have been in the re-settlement process for years, congregations have stepped up in many ways. Week of Compassion's "Immigrant and Refugee Response" helps experienced Disciples continue their ministry, and those new to the response find ways to get started.

GIFTS TO LIVE ON ... Caring for Children After the Maui Fires

With at least 2200 structures destroyed (85% residential), it will be years before rebuilding will be complete. Week of Compassion partnered with "Children's Disaster Services" offering a compassionate response and care focused on children, as parents navigated the first days of reaction and recovery.



After coming back from what felt like an extended Winter Break, we are picking up the pace already for our 2024/25 year. Preschool Registration is now open and thriving! If we could accept every registration we would! However, the Department of Human Services decides how many preschoolers will fit in our classrooms and we fill those spaces quickly. If you registered your child and are placed on a waiting list, know that our rosters tend to change after the public school announces theirs.

Our preschoolers came back after our break to a fun surprise in their classrooms! The four/five year olds started the school year with a health clinic, a vet clinic, and a home office as their dramatic play centers and the three year olds started the school year with a home center and a grocery store as their dramatic play centers. The teachers and I kept a little secret about them and over break we traded those centers between classrooms. This was such a fun way to refresh their classroom spaces as well as provide the opportunity for the teachers to rearrange and sanitize their supplies. We also came back from break to beautiful new flooring in the four year old classroom! We are so grateful to the church for providing this much needed update to our classroom.

We will also be squeezing in outdoor playtime as the weather permits. I fully understand how cumbersome it can be to send snow gear back and forth with your preschooler. Our playground is completely shaded for majority of our day. While this is great for us during the warmer months, the winter months are FRIGID as it is shaded and windy. We try to do our best and catch the weather at just the right time so we can get some fresh air so we do appreciate you sending their gear.
