





The Doodle Prayer

- 1. Write out your prayer.
- 2. Doodle around your prayers.
- 3. Place your hand over each prayer in turn and lift that person or situation up to God.
- 4. End.

Prayer Walk

- 1. Choose a location that you'd like to pray over.
- 2. As you physically walk pray over the people, situations, circumstances, the work done here, and the needs that come to mind.
- 3. Thank God for the people and the places that you have been praying for.

Listening Prayer

- 1. Find a quiet space.
- 2. Take a few deeps breaths.
- 3. Ask God to be with you in the silence and to speak to your heart.
- 4. Sit in silence and listen for God.
- 5. Take note of what God places on your heart.



HOW WE PRAY

Trying different forms of prayer can allow both kids and adults to connect with God in different ways. Some folks like more contemplative prayer practices, and some like the more active and creative prayer practices. Here are some different prayer practices. Each of these models are meant to give your prayer time some structure, and to help you connect with God in different ways. Some of these are helpful acronyms to guide your prayer time, and some are more creative and active prayer practices that involve doodling or walking around your house, your workplace, or your neighborhood.
